Specifically, this module covers how to identify various forms of asbestos, adverse health effects due to asbestos exposure, effects of combining asbestos exposure and smoking, the Asbestos Medical Surveillance Program, various building materials that may contain asbestos, and building management control options.

### **Asbestos Awareness Training: Part 2 of 3 -**

Provides an overview of how to identify and avoid exposure to asbestos. Specifically, this module covers the purpose and proper use of respirators, other Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and protective control options, decontamination procedure, and hygiene facilities and practices.

### **Asbestos Awareness Training: Part 3 of 3 -**

Provides an overview of asbestos training requirements and regulations. Specifically, this module covers housekeeping procedures, waste disposal, air quality monitoring, asbestos fiber release episodes, PELs, OSHA and EPA regulations and training.
