Training Spotlight - New Courses Available!

1. **Connecticut UST Class A/B Certification Program** - This comprehensive 9 module Underground Storage Tank training program features the following topics:

- UST Operator Training Requirements
- Underground Storage Tanks
- Spill and Overfill Prevention
- Release Detection
- Corrosion Control
- UST Financial Requirements

2. **Drinking Water: Revised Total Coliform Rule** - This module educates on the Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR) as one of the national primary drinking water regulations that protect the safety of drinking water in the U.S. Awareness topics include: introduction and purpose of the RTCR, applicability and compliance timeline, requirements under RTCR, Maximum Contaminate Level (MCL), MCL violations, sample siting plans, monitoring, routine samples, repeat samples, assessments and corrective actions, Treatment Technique (TT) Triggers and corrective actions, recordkeeping and reporting, public notification requirements, and best practices for PWSs.

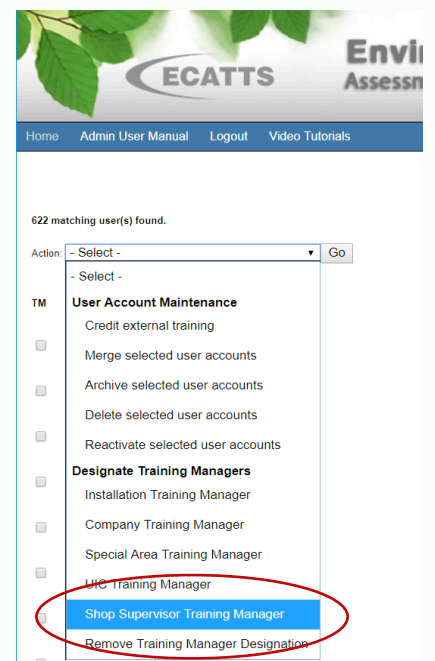
Keep an eye out for the following new courses still to come as part of the full Drinking Water series:

- **Drinking water: Lead in Priority Areas (LIPA)** - This module introduces pertinent Navy policy regarding the EPA's lead guidelines and describes sampling and notification procedures.
- **Drinking Water: Public Notification Rule and the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR)** - This training outlines the requirements of the Public Notification Rule and provides references and samples to facilitate compliance.
- 3. **Navy Environmental Management System (EMS) Awareness (for Installation Commanding Officers and Executive Officers)** - This module explains key points of the EMS process for Commanding and Executive officers and includes information on SECNAV Policy 5090.8A, sustainability, DoD Strategic Sustainability Performance Plan (SSPP), sustainable regions and installations, sustainability linkages, OPNAVINST 5090.1D, EMS definition (OPNAV M-5090.1), 17-3 requirements (OPNAV M-5090.1), EMS Plan-Do-Check-Act process, impacts and risk, comparison of NOV's received, host and tenant relationships (OPNAV M-5090.1 1-3.2.f), and the benefits of a successful EMS.

Updates & Enhancements

The new role of "Shop Supervisor" has recently been added to your training site. Once assigned by an Administrator, this new user can access authorized areas by clicking on their Shop Supervisor link in the gray navigation bar located on the main screen.

This role allows the designated user to review available training and access the "Training Via Briefing" functionality to record offline training for personnel that are not in the system.



Winter Support Tip

Are you an Administrator or Training Manager and find that an individual's training records are not visible on your reports? A common occurrence is that the user's profile is not set to the same base as the Administrator. Luckily, this is easily remedied. The user simply needs to log into his/her account and click on MY PROFILE to select the correct base.
