Alaska News

Alaska is one of the first six states to receive approval for the NEPA Assignment Program. Through this program, project reviews are streamlined and the Alaska DOT&PF assumes responsibilities under NEPA and all or part of FHWA's responsibilities for environmental review, consultation, or other actions required under any Federal environmental law for federally funded highway projects in Alaska.

ECATTS has added NEPA Assignment Program training to the Alaska DOT&PF training site. The training reviews NEPA, the NEPA Review Process, and presents the requirements for preparing and processing environmental documentation for the NEPA Assignment Program. It is intended to be used in conjunction with AKDOT&PF Environmental Procedures Manual.

Course Developments

We are currently in the process of developing new training for The Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR). The RTCR is the revision to the 1989 Total Coliform Rule (TCR) that applies to all public water systems. This training will explain contaminate levels, monitoring requirements, Level 1 and 2 assessments and corrective actions, reporting and recordkeeping, violations, public notification and consumer confidence reports.
